In order to maintain a high level of ruchnius in camp, and a Torah true atmosphere throughout the summer IM"Y we have established these very worthwhile rules. Please give them your full attention.

1. Non-Jewish tapes of any kind are not permitted in camp. Anyone possessing or listening to such tapes may be asked to leave camp with no refund given.
2. Books containing indecent material, (often found in non-Jewish novels, etc.) are not permitted into camp. Anyone found reading or owning such books will be asked to leave camp. The books will be confiscated and not returned.
3. Comic books (especially of the "super hero" variety) are not permitted in camp. They will be confiscated and not returned.
4. Non-Jewish newspapers are not permitted in camp.
5. T-shirts depicting movie, TV or comic themes are not permitted in camp. They will be removed and not returned.
6. Posters depicting movie, TV or comic themes are not permitted in camp. They will be taken away and not returned.
7. Any staff using foul language will be sent home. Camp Ruach Hachaim will not tolerate improper words or jokes. A number of complaints have been mentioned to us about this problem.
8. Defacing of camp property causes untold damage to the value and appearance of camp. Please be forewarned that defacing of camp property will result in full payment for the damage plus a fine and could result in expulsion from camp. Destroying camp property will not be tolerated.
9. Smoking and the use of narcotics is not permitted in camp or out. Don't get caught with cigarettes. It may cost you your job and your salary.
10. Staff members found going to movies will be asked to leave camp and will lose their salaries.
11. Staff members, don't even think of driving any vehicle without permission from the camp director (Rabbi Scharf). If you do, you'll be driven out of camp.
12. If you leave camp without permission, (even on a day off you must ask) it will be a one way trip! Please don't try it.
13. All staff members must come to davening (of all tefillos) with socks and long pants.
14. All staff members are required to obey the owner and head counselor of Camp Kochavim.
15. All staff members must be back on time on their day(s) off.

CONDITIONS OF ENROLLMENT

I agree to adhere to all rules and regulations which govern: 1- the CRH registration process 2- my son's stay/employment at camp, and 3- payment schedules and terms.

It is expressly understood and agreed that CRH reserves the unrestricted right to dismiss, without a refund, anyone whose conduct or influence is deemed detrimental to the camp operation or inimical to the best interest of the camp.

There will be a reduction in salary for late arrival or early departure.

We reserve the right to make counselors rotators.

The cost for the replacement of any items damaged due to misuse, willful destruction or loss by the counselor rotations, will be deducted from their salary.

I acknowledge that, although CRH operates with the highest

safety standards and has taken measures to minimize the risk of injury to camp participants, CRH cannot insure nor guarantee that the participants, equipment, premises, and/or activities will be free of hazards, accidents or injuries. I recognize these inherent risks and understand that I have assumed these risks by allowing my son to work for CRH. Furthermore, I have instructed my son in the importance of knowing and abiding by the camp rules, regulations and procedures for the safety of camp participants.

I agree to abide by all camp rules and procedures regarding medical care as detailed in the Terms of Agreement.

CRH is authorized to use analog and/or digital photographic, audio and/or video reproductions of my son electronically and in literature for promotional purposes.

Acceptance as a staff member is subject to the camp checking all references and review of the pertinent information, even for returning staff members.

CRH will not be held responsible for clothing or personal effects lost or damaged by fire, theft, or laundry. Once the camp season ends, all personal items will be disposed of by the janitorial staff.

CRH is not responsible nor liable for Counselors activities on their days off.
